Need help deciding where to donate 10th Mountain related items as you clear, clean and organize your homes and consciences? This handy dandy Donation Guide is for you! It lists all known 10th Mountain related museums, organizations and institutions, briefly outlines the kind of items they accept, and provides contact information. Help keep 10th Mountain items out of the dumpster, clip this list today!

First off, the 10th Mountain Resource Center is the first choice destination for letters, photos, maps, movies, artwork, diaries, journals, manuals, books or booklets (any one-dimensional item of graphic, photographic or written nature).

However, there is no shortage of 10th items out there that are outside the Resource Center's scope and mission. While it is safest to first ask the 10th Mountain Resource Center if they're interested in an item, please feel free to pursue options listed here if they are not.

If you have very many items, it is very useful to make an itemized list of the items. With photographs, it's ideal if the person donating them could provide dates and especially identification on any of the people in the photographs. Often we get Camp Hale photos and simply have to guess that they are either 1943 or 1944, for example.
